Course Overview

This 40+ hour Montana POST certified course is for commissioned law enforcement officers responsible for responding to critical incidents with reduced staffing. This course will combine classroom instruction with practical exercises. All the basic skills needed by patrol/other officers responding to critical incidents will be covered in this course.

Topics covered include, but are not limited to

- Less Lethal Force Philosophy
- Breaching
- Scouting
- Team and Individual Movement
- High Risk Warrant Service
- Barricaded Suspects

- CQB and Room Clearing
 - static and dynamic movement
- Arrest Team Tactics
- Rescues
- Immediate Action Drills
- Incident Debriefs

Student Equipment Requirements

- All individually assigned gear (if issued/owned)
- Helmet (if issued), duty belt and/or outer vest, ballistic protection (heavy vest, plate carrier, and soft armor if issued), uniform, rifle, pistol, radio and com gear, eye and ear protection.

Room and Board at MLEA

- Optional. This is for people who plan to stay at MLEA and eat all meals at MLEA
- Lodging = \$100 per student. Meals = \$150 per student.
