Course Overview

This 60+ hour Montana POST certified course is for commissioned LE officers assigned to a tactical team, and will combine classroom instruction with practical exercises. All the basic skills needed by new SWAT officers will be covered in this course.

Topics covered include, but are not limited to

- Less Lethal Force Philosophy
- Breaching
- Scouting
- Team and Individual Movement
- High Risk Warrant Service
- Barricaded Suspects

- CQB and Room Clearing
 - static and dynamic movement
- Arrest Team Tactics
- Rescues
- Immediate Action Drills
- Incident Debriefs

Student Equipment Requirements

- All individually assigned tactical gear
- Helmet, ballistic protection (heavy vest or plate carrier), tactical uniform(s), rifle, pistol, radio & com gear, eye & ear protection, and gas mask (required)
- 350 rounds rifle, 350 rounds pistol

Room and Board

- Optional. This is for people who plan to stay at MLEA and eat all meals at MLEA
- Lodging = \$120 per student. Meals = \$160 per student.
